

## Spare Wax Traps 54-269 Replacing Used Wax Traps from Canford Wireless Earpieces




- The tool has a metal thread at one end and a plastic stub on the other.
- 2 To remove the used wax trap from the earpiece use the metal thread end of the tool.




a Insert the threaded of the tool end into the wax trap and whilst doing so lightly twist the tool clockwise, (as if you were screwing the tool into the trap). One complete turn should be enough.



- b Pull the tool out and the wax trap should be on the end.
- c Dispose appropriately of the trap.
- 3 To insert a new trap into the earpiece use the plastic stub end of the tool.




- a Index the Dial pack dispenser to an available wax trap.
- b Simply push the stub end into the wax trap and withdraw the tool. The Wax trap should be held onto the end of the tool.



c Push the wax trap using the tool into the earpiece.
