



Canford – UK REACH Regulations Statement

REACH, the European Union Regulation (EC 1907/2006) on the Registration, Evaluation, Authorisation and Restriction of Chemicals, entered into force on June 1, 2007. Under the European Union (Withdrawal) Act 2018, the EU REACH Regulation was brought into UK law on 1 January 2021 and is now known as UK REACH.

Canford does not manufacture or import, to the best of its knowledge and belief, any materials which would cause us to become registrants under the regulations. Neither does Canford manufacture or distribute any articles which are designed to release substances, particularly substances of very high concern (SVHCs) as defined in the UK REACH Regulations, in normal use and in normal operating conditions. Currently, based on information provided by suppliers, to the best of our knowledge no substances in Canford supplied products are contained in the latest list of SVHC (known as the candidate list) which can be found on the HSE Gov website:

We do, in the course of standard business, use and distribute a limited number of chemicals (from reputable UK/EU sources) which are commonly found in our industry sector for cleaning or lubrication applications. In the course of such trade, we have always offered appropriate MSDS sheets and encouraged feedback should any problems be encountered in use by our customers (so far there have been no such instances in over 40 years of experience). We will, of course continue to provide such information and support the exchange of any relevant safety data.
